Procedure for slime.

1. Mix $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of glue and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water in a bowl.
2. Add food colouring to the mixture.
3. Pour $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of borax solution into the mixture and stir. The slime will begin to form.
4. Stir the slime as much as you can and then knead it with your hands until it gets less sticky.
5. Store the slime in a plastic bag in the fridge.
