Multiplication 3

Multiplying **by zero** means you have no groups of the number you want to multiply.

$3 \times 0 = 0$
3 groups of nothing is still nothing.
 $15 \times 0 = 0$ or $0 \times 15 = 0$

Multiplying **by 1** (the number stays the same)

$5 \times 1 = 5$
5 groups of 1 = 5

Multiplying **by 10** (just add a **0** to the number)

e.g $15 \times 1 = 15$
 $15 \times 10 = 150$

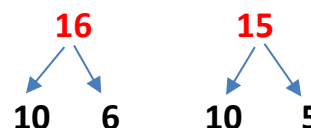
