

Dogs

1. Research your favourite breed of dog and write three facts about it.
2. Draw a picture of your favourite dog, label the drawing and write a few sentences about the picture. It might be a family pet, a dog from a television programme or simply a favourite breed.
3. Design a leaflet for a vet clinic, outlining advice for responsible pet ownership e.g. It is important to get your pet dog vaccinated, licence etc. Make the leaflet nice and colourful so it catches the eye of the clients entering the clinic.
4. Draw a vet clinic scene. Label the animals in the clinic. Write a paragraph describing what is in the scene e.g. why are the animals in the vet clinic? Were they sick? Injured? How is their owner feeling?
5. Research working dogs. Name 3 different breeds of dog which are working dogs. Pick one and write five facts about the dogs work.
6. Make a garden for a dog out of Lego or playdough.
7. Go for a walk in your neighbourhood with your family and discuss what types and breeds of dogs you see.
