Work out the answers.</p> <p>Remember to look for the adding and take away words in the word problems. Underline the important words. Draw out the problem if you need to. Best of luck! Upload to Seesaw please.</p>	<p>Spelling: under, above, below & beside. Put the words in sentences please girls. Jolly Phonics p56 the 'oy' sound as in toy and p57 adverbs. Adverbs describes the verb i.e. how something is done – quickly, loudly etc. Two Little Frogs p86 & p87. On p87 Activity A wants you to use the pictures to make compound words. Activity B wants you to use the red and green words to do the same. Read the next page in MRAH.</p>	<p>P79 Today you will be playing snakes and ladders while practicing your numbers 'as Ghaeilge' (in Irish). Check Seesaw to hear me say the numbers and repeat after me. Best of luck with the game!</p>	<p>Choose one activity from the themed learning The Beach and upload to Seesaw.</p>
Tuesday	<p>P149 & 150. Girls today we are going back to money. Remember the coins we have – 1c, 2c, 5c, 10c, 20 and 50c. Do we have one coin for 3c, 4c, 6c, 7c, 8c or 9c? No, we don't – so these must be made up from other coins. Read the questions carefully. Add up each set and write your total next to the coins. Upload to Seesaw please by pressing the + add response tab.</p>	<p>Spelling: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. Please put the words in sentences girls. P88 & 89 Two Little Frogs: p 88 is your reading for tonight – read the story quietly and then retell the story to your parent in the correct order. p89 Answer the questions in Activity A and then do Activity B. Jolly Phonics: p58 'or' sound like horse and p59 'sh, ch, s or x' word endings. When you need to make these plural, you need to add 'es' not just 's' e.g. brushes, porches, dresses & foxes.</p>	<p>P80. Feicim le mo shúilín – I spy with my little eye. Words beginning with 'r'. Wednesday	<p>P151 & p 152. Hi Girls, today we are still working with money. Read the question to find out what to do. Hint: add up each group and write the answer next to the group before you start colouring (p152). Money p 153 add up the coins and find the hidden word in the word search box e.g. 15 is fifteen.</p>	<p>Spelling: Friday, Saturday, Sunday & week. Please put the words into sentences girls. Read this week's poem below – it is called The Bluebell Fairies, author unknown. What do you think of this poem? Write or record on Seesaw, a conversation between the fairies. Draw a picture if you like! Two Little Frogs p 90 – Activity A look at the picture and write the word; Activity B – tick the correct word. Jolly Phonics: p60 'al' sometimes we hear the 'al' sound as in wall but sometimes it is silent as in 'talk'. Read the first half of the book in the email.</p>	<p>P81 Léigh an Scéal (Read the story). Let's read about Niamh going shopping. Listen and repeat on Seesaw. Have fun colouring girls☺</p>	<p>I am sure that the sun is on its way back to us. To enjoy the sun and keep it out of your eyes checkout the Seesaw activity for a sun visor!</p>

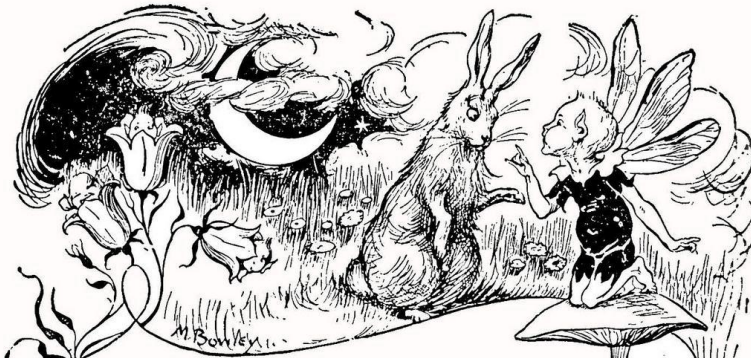
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>P154 – another money exercise. In Q3 read the question carefully – they want you to use the LEAST amount of coins e.g. 10c + 5c to make 15c.</p> <p>p155 We are going back to subtraction and subtracting UNITS only. Q 1 Draw cubes to show the number $38 - 4 =$. In Q 3 & 4 you need to keep the units under the units to make sure that you take units away from units, and not from tens. Try the challenge too, I know you can do it!! Upload the answers to Seesaw please.</p>	<p>Spelling: spring, summer, autumn, winter. Please put the words into sentences girls. Two Little Frogs p90 Activities A & B. Jolly Phonics: p61 Look at the picture, write and draw the opposite to what you see. p62 ‘nk’ sound. Write about what you need to go on a fairy hunt – this week’s poem may help – will you go during the day or in the evening? Will you be noisy or quiet? Will you feel chilly or warm? Upload to Seesaw please girls. Finish the book in the email and write your book review. Upload your review to Seesaw.</p>	<p>P82 An Nuacht – today’s news is all about the toy shop and the weather! Listen to the instructions on Seesaw.</p>	<p>Write your book review (book in email) on Seesaw.</p>
<p>Friday</p>	<p>p156 Here we are taking away 10’s from a number so you will be taking away 10, 20, 30 etc. Look at these 10’s numbers – they all have 0 in the unit place. So taking away a 0 unit from another units won’t change the answer e.g. $4 - 0 = 4$. So $28 - 10 = 18$ – no change to the unit.</p> <p>Girls you can do p 157 on Monday if you do not have time to do it today – This is very like adding in the tens and units house except now we are using the take away or minus sign. It is important as always to keep the units under the units and the tens under the tens and to ALWAYS start taking away with the units.</p>	<p>Spelling: friend, cousin, are, or. Please put the words into sentences girls. Two Little Frogs p91 Activity A & B. Jolly Phonics p64 & 65 The ‘er’ sound and speech marks. We will skip p63 as we did not get the chance to use the dictionary in class.</p> <p>Many flowers have their special fairy like the Bluebell Fairy, the Buttercup Fairy and so on. Choose your favourite flower and draw what you think its fairy might be.</p> <p>Here is a lovely website to give you some ideas but you must have a parent with you to investigate! https://flowerfairies.com/meet-the-fairies/</p>	<p>P73 The Fox and the Little Red Hen. Listen to the words on Seesaw and repeat after me. Ask your daughter questions about the book, ask her to ask you questions about the book. Themed work is The Beach.</p>
