<b>Maths</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Activity 1:</b>            Have a discussion about money, when we use it, what coins they know etc.            Find some toys and coins (1c/2c/5c) and make some price tags. You can make the coins if you need to.            Have a game of shop and why not take it outdoors if it is sunny!</li>   <li>• <b>Activity 2:</b>            Make the numbers 1-10 out of playdough or whatever you can find. Find the correct number of objects for each set. e.g. 5 cars under the number 5.            Try to find things in the house first and then do it again in the garden.</li>   <li>• <b>Activity 3:</b>            With a piece of chalk make the outline of a hop-scotch. In the hop-scotch write sums up to a total of 10 e.g. 7+3 etc. Throw a stone and answer the sum that you land on!</li>   <li>• <b>Activity 4:</b>            Shape hunt- go on a shape hunt in your house. You can do it for 2d shapes like squares, circles, triangles, rectangles or 3D shapes like cubes, spheres, cones and cuboids. If the weather is nice you could always do it outside!</li> </ul>

**Step 1: Draw the dandelion stem and the lines for the seeds.**

**Step 2: Use your fingers and paint to dot on the fluffy part of the dandelions seed.**

**Note: Another option would be to paint the stem and dot on the seeds using white paint and your fingers. I think both ways look great so decide which one you prefer yourself! 😊**
